



Chambolle-Musigny 1er Cru Les Sentiers

Premier Cru CHAMBOLLE-MUSIGNY Les Sentiers

Geographic Description

Chambolle takes its name from the bubbling appearance of the Le Grône stream. It was in 1878 that the name of its best Cru Musigny was added to the name of the village. This A.O.C. exists only for red wines and has a total surface area of 182 ha. Trails simply indicates the presence of trails and paths. There are three crossroads of paths around the edge of the climate.

Geological Description

The vines are located on a path which leads to Clos de Vougeot. Only the Route des Grands Crus separates one end of Bonnes-Mares, on the border of Chambolle and Morey. The vines are planted on fairly deep clay soil.
